

Camp Motorsport/Chef Camp

WHAT TO BRING TO CAMP – FOR ADULT/CHILD WEEKENDS

EACH participant – Child AND Adult - must bring: Health Form Waiver Form

CLOTHING:

Shorts Socks: 2 pair per day T-Shirts: 2 per day
 Underwear Pajamas Jeans/Long pants
 Sweatshirt/Jacket Raincoat/poncho Sneakers
 Swimsuit Motorsport Campers: Bring an extra pair of sneakers for wet/muddy driving conditions

Sneakers are mandatory footwear for all program activity areas. No sandals, open-toe shoes or slipper-type shoes-including "crocks"-are allowed. Flip flops are permitted in the living areas and swimming pool.

PERSONAL ITEMS:

Sunscreen Insect repellent Sunglasses
 Flashlight Shampoo Soap
 Toothbrush & Toothpaste Hair Brush Deodorant
 Beach Towel for pool Any medications Etc. as needed

LINENS:

Bed Linens: (to fit single bed): Bed sheets & blanket or sleeping bag Pillow
 Bath Towel(s) Hand Towel Washcloth Beach Towel(s)

OPTIONAL ITEMS:

Camera Hat for sun protection Fishing gear
 Bottled Water/Sports Drinks Snacks Lawn Chair
 Trash bag(s) to transport wet/muddy clothing home after driving Flashlight

Bicycles Etc.: Participants are welcome to bring their own bicycles, skateboards, skates, or non-electric scooters. Helmets must be worn by all riders/skaters at all times. Riders assume all risks.

Alcohol Use: The use of alcohol by adults of legal age is permitted on site, however must be confined to the assigned lodging, or designated area(s). Alcohol use is not permitted prior to or during any camp-provided program activities. Individuals who are impaired/under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol are prohibited from participation in camp-provided activities. The camp reserves the right to not allow participation in activities by those under the influence, and to remove individuals from the camp property, with no refund of fees. The consumption of alcohol by adults who have responsibilities for the supervision of youth participants is strongly discouraged.

PROHIBITED ITEMS: Pets, fireworks, firearms or other weapons, ammunition, or any similar objects, motorized scooters, mopeds, dirt bikes, or ATV's, combustible materials, objects with an open flame of any kind (candles, incense, etc.) grills, toaster ovens, hot plates, space heaters, halogen lamps, any appliance with visible heating elements

Youth under the age of 16 are not permitted to drive passenger vehicles on camp property. Transport of anyone in the back/bed of a pickup truck or trailer is prohibited on camp property.

The camp is not responsible for loss, theft, or damages to any personal items brought to camp.
